The Danville Chapter of AMBUCS announced today that a series of free concerts will be held at Temple Plaza in 2015. The "Ambucs Music Series" will be open to the public and will feature 6 live performances every other Friday starting on May 29, 2015. A variety of music is planned, from classic rock to modern country. The bar will open at 5:00pm with bands playing from 6:00pm to 9:00pm each evening. Food vendors will be on hand as well.

AMBUCS volunteers will organize the concerts, hire the bands, and will sell beverages at each event. Many area businesses will sponsor and support the series, and will receive marketing recognition and other benefits. AMBUCS will be seeking additional sponsors over the coming months.

At the venue, the Danville AMBUCS plan to highlight many of their projects this event will support, including providing specially designed therapeutic tricycles to persons with disabilities, a two week local summer camp for children with special needs, scholarships for therapy students, Challenger League baseball, and all-access playgrounds at three city parks. Danville Ambucs are dedicated to creating mobility and independence for persons with disabilities, especially children.

Dates for 2015 are May 29, June 12, June 26, July 10, July 24, and August 7. Bands selected will be announced in the Spring.
